### Associate Membership

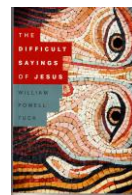
Franklin Baptist Church now offers an associate membership option. This would be for those individuals who may not be in a position to join under the regular membership option. We can receive associate members in the following ways:

The associate membership would have all of the rights, privileges, and responsibilities of the regular membership except:

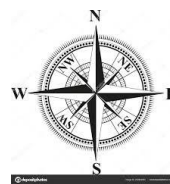
- The associate member would not be able to serve as a deacon.

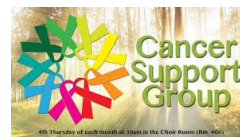
Deacon Ordination and Installation is **Sunday January 12<sup>th</sup>** at the 11:00 AM service.
