# CHARLES QUALLS TO BE INTERVIEWED AND HEARD WORLDWIDE ON DAY1 RADIO

Catch two sermons in January by Dr. Qualls on Day1 Radio or Day1 online. Day1 Radio (formerly "The Protestant Hour") has been broadcasting worldwide since 1945. Today, Day1 is distributed via their website (<a href="http://day1.org/radio">http://day1.org/radio</a>) or their Facebook page (<a href="https://www.facebook.com/day1online/">https://www.facebook.com/day1online/</a>). Still a mainstay on radio as well, Day1 is carried on over 220 stations especially in the U.S., but also the Caribbean, Canada, Africa and New Zealand.
