## PSALMS 60.2—62.6

Thou hast made the land to tremble; thou hast rent it: the breaches thereof; it shaketh.  
Thou hast showed thy people hard things:  
Thou hast made us to drink the dregs of staggering.  
Thou hast given a banner to them that fear thee.  
It may be displayed because of the truth. (Sé'lah) Thy beloved may be desired.  
Thou hast smitten him with thy right hand, and answered us.  
Thou hast spoken in his holiness: I will exult; I will divide Shé'chem, and will mete out the valley of Succoth.  
The land is mine, and Má-nás'sion is mine;  
Sion also is the defence of my head:  
The sceptre is in my hand, and the bow is in my washpot;  
I will cast my bow: I will shout because of me.  
Will thou bring me into the city?  
Thou hast led me unto E'dóm? I will not say, O God, cast me off?  
Thou knowest not forth, O God, with our hosts.  
Thou shalt help against the adversary:  
The help of man is vain; with God we shall do valiantly:  
For he it is that will tread down our adversaries.

3 For thou hast been a refuge for me.  
A strong tower from the enemy.  
4 I will dwell in thy tabernacle for ever:

6 Thou wilt prolong the king's life: His years shall be as many generations.  
7 He shall abide before God for ever:  
Oh prepare lovingkindness and truth, that they may preserve him.  
8 So will I sing praise unto thy name for ever.  
That I may daily perform my vows.

For the Chief Musicians; after the manner of Jeduthun. A Psalm of David.  
62 My soul waiteth in silence for God only:  
From him cometh my salvation.  
2 He only is my rock and my salvation:  
He is my high tower; I shall not be greatly moved.  
3 How long will ye set upon a man.  
That ye may slay him, all of you.  
Like a leaning wall, like a tottering fence?
