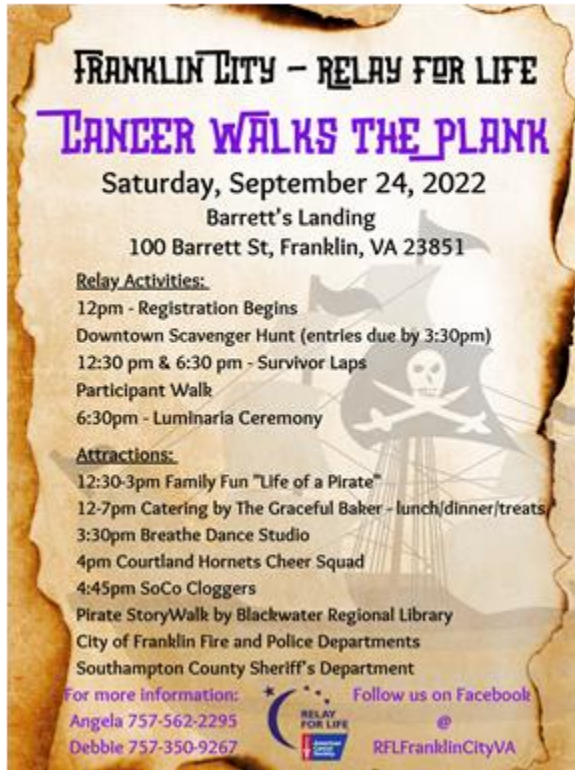

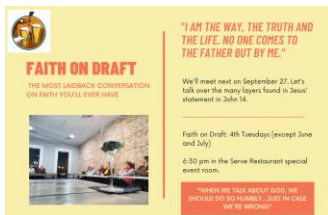
We are so excited to have The Graceful Baker as our onsite food vendor! She will have lunch, dinner, and yummy treats available from 12:00 to 7:00 PM.
