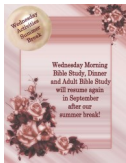
### FRANKLIN COOPERATIVE MINISTRY

Franklin Cooperative Ministry will be collecting hand soap during the month of June.



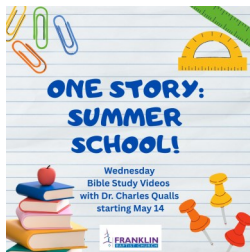
### FAITH ON DRAFT – SUMMER BREAK
