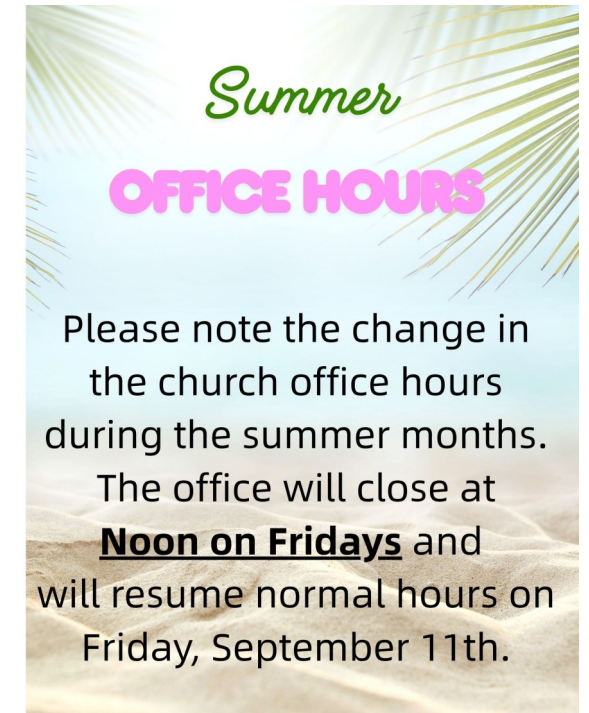

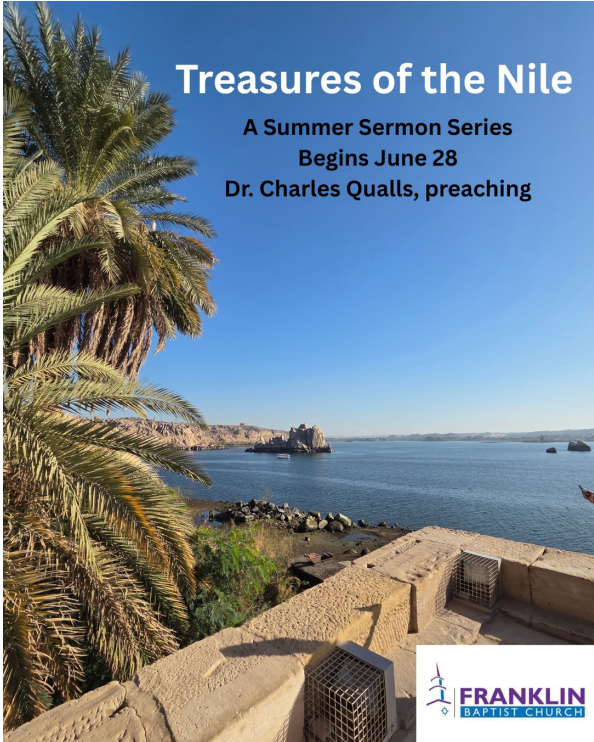
Through our Lord Jesus Christ we have obtained access to the grace in which we stand. With confidence in God's grace, let us confess our sin.

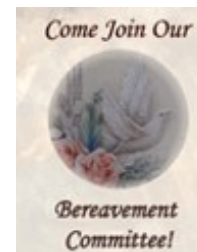
FRANKLIN COOPERATIVE MINISTRY
